The world's first social mobile.

This is beyond a web phone. This is a social networking mobile designed to keep you in touch and online wherever you are. Web essentials like Facebook, Skype, eBay and Windows Live Messenger are always on, always connected, ensuring you're never out of touch.

We believe your phone should do the hard work for you and that you shouldn't need a degree in nuclear physics to work it. Now here's the Switcher. It runs along the bottom of your Home screen with all your favourite applications, so they're easy to get to and quick to open.

Your Contacts used to be just a static list. Not now. We've brought it to life, integrating your Facebook, Skype and Windows Live contacts so when your friends' status (or even their profile pictures) change, you'll see it live in your Contacts.

It's never been quicker or easier to get online and keep connected with the things that matter to you.

To get straight to a section, just click on the titles opposite.

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First things first.

There are a few things you need to do to get your mobile working. Things like inserting your USIM and battery and setting time and date. Then there are the things that personalise the phone, like setting wallpaper.

Getting ready to go. That's what this section is all about.

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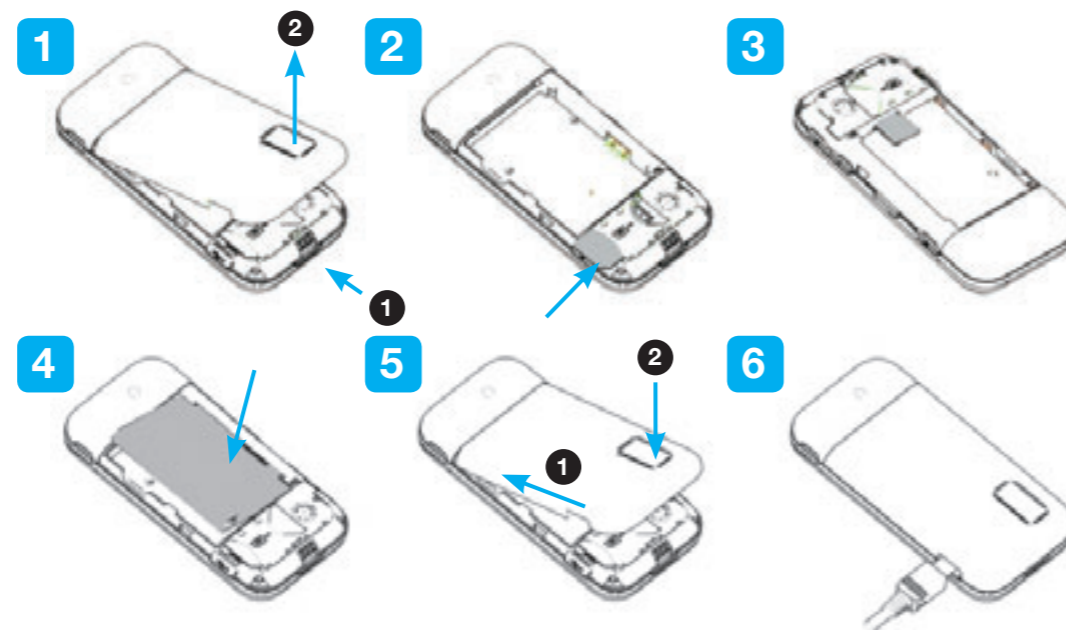
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INSERT YOUR USIM, BATTERY AND MEMORY CARD, AND CHARGE YOUR MOBILE

Your 3 USIM can only be used in mobiles which are enabled for 3 services. If you try to use the USIM in other mobiles you could seriously damage the mobile and may be unable to use it, including making emergency calls. If you do that, we are not responsible for any such damage or usage problems.

Fully charge the battery before using it for the first time.



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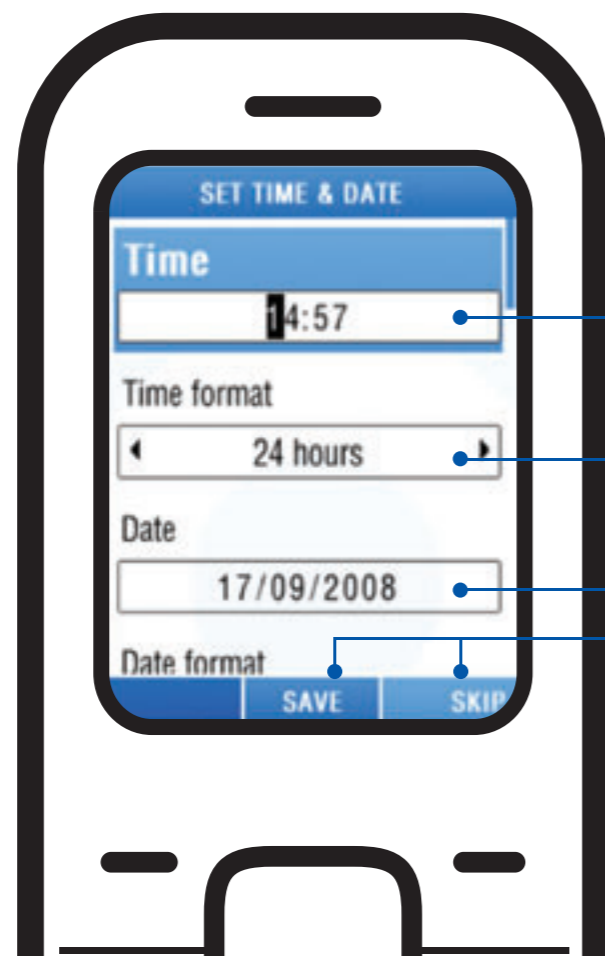
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WIZARD

The Wizard will appear when you first turn on your mobile to take you through setting the time and date and also plays a short video. You need to go through the Wizard so that your phone will work properly.



Set the current time.

Then select your preferred time format.

Set the date.

Then press SAVE or SKIP if you want to set the time and date later.

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TURN YOUR PHONE ON AND OFF

POWER ON

- Press and hold  to switch on your phone.

POWER OFF

- Press and hold  to switch off the mobile.

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SET TIME AND DATE

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select **SETTINGS > Time & date.**
- Enter the date and time.
- Select **SAVE.**

CHOOSE A WALLPAPER

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select **SETTINGS > Display > Main screen.**
- Scroll to **Show wallpaper > SELECT > select your preferred image > SELECT > SAVE.**
- You can also select **Show clock > ENABLE.**

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SET YOUR RINGTONE

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select **SETTINGS > Profiles**.
- Select Normal or other profiles > **OPTIONS > Edit > OK**.
- Select Ringtones & alerts > **CHANGE > select your preferred tune from Track or Artist or Album etc. > SELECT**.

SET YOUR SCREEN SAVER

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select **SETTINGS > Display > Screensaver setting**. Select Image > select your preferred image > **SELECT**.
- Or you can select Date & time > **ENABLE** or select **OFF** to turn off the screen saver.

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SET UP VOICEMAIL

- Press and hold **1**. Follow the voice prompts to choose a PIN and record your greeting.

SET UP VIDEOMAIL

- Press and hold **2** for a video call. Then follow the voice prompts to record your video greeting.

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CHOOSE A TEXT ENTRY METHOD

The multipress, T9 and numeric input modes can be changed by pressing **[*]#** within a text box.

- **ABC Input:** use the keypad to enter letters, numbers, symbols, and other characters. Press the same key repeatedly to cycle through available characters. If you do not press a key for two seconds, the character in the block cursor is accepted, and the cursor moves to the next position.
- **T9 Text Input:** you press each key only once, even if the character you want is not the first character on the key. It tries to predict the word.
- **123 Input:** if you want to input a series of numbers, you need to change to 123 mode or press and hold the particular key for three seconds.
- **Symbol Input:** In ABC and 123 mode, short press **[*]#** and you can access the symbol menu. While in T9 mode, press and hold **[*]#** for a few seconds to access the symbol menu.
- Select **OPTIONS >** Dictionary > Add to/Go to, to view the dictionary or add new words to it.
- Press **[*]#** and scroll to select **ENG** to change the writing language. The options are:

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Your mobile can do a lot of things.

This section explains what all the icons and symbols mean, and shows you how to find your way around your mobile.

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Familiarise yourself with its features.



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YOUR MOBILE'S SCREEN

Your mobile's screen is divided into four basic screens:
the Status bar, the Main Screen, Switcher and the Prompt box.



STATUS BAR

Shows what operations are taking place, the battery and signal strength. See the next page for status icon details.

HOME SCREEN

If you are not on the Home screen, the screen will show the main menu or the submenu related to that particular feature.

SWITCHER

Quick access to all open applications and easy to close open applications.

THE PROMPT BOX

Displays various prompts in the soft key boxes. These are activated by pressing the appropriate left and right soft key under each one.

	Memory full – appears when the mobile memory is nearly full. In this case it may be necessary to release some memory on your mobile
	Calendar – appears on the day when a calendar event exists
	Video call forward
	Voice call forward
	Minimise Music – music is playing in the background

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SWITCHER

No more tedious trawling through menus to find the things you use most often. The Switcher gives you instant access to things like Google or Facebook via a scrollable menu at the bottom of the Home screen. It shows your most important applications and anything you've got open at the moment.

You can choose to add or take away icons from the carousel, so if you've got a favourite application you can get to it straight away.

When you're using an application and you call up the Switcher, the home icon appears in the centre.

If the phone is idle, the home icon doesn't appear (seeing as you're already there).

- To add an item to the Switcher customise area, select **OPTIONS > Add items to switcher**.
- To remove item from the Switcher customise area, select **OPTIONS > Remove from switcher**.
- To set Switcher mode to Active one touch Switcher, select **OPTIONS > Activate one touch switcher**.
- To access an open application, use left or right key to select the application and then press **OK**.

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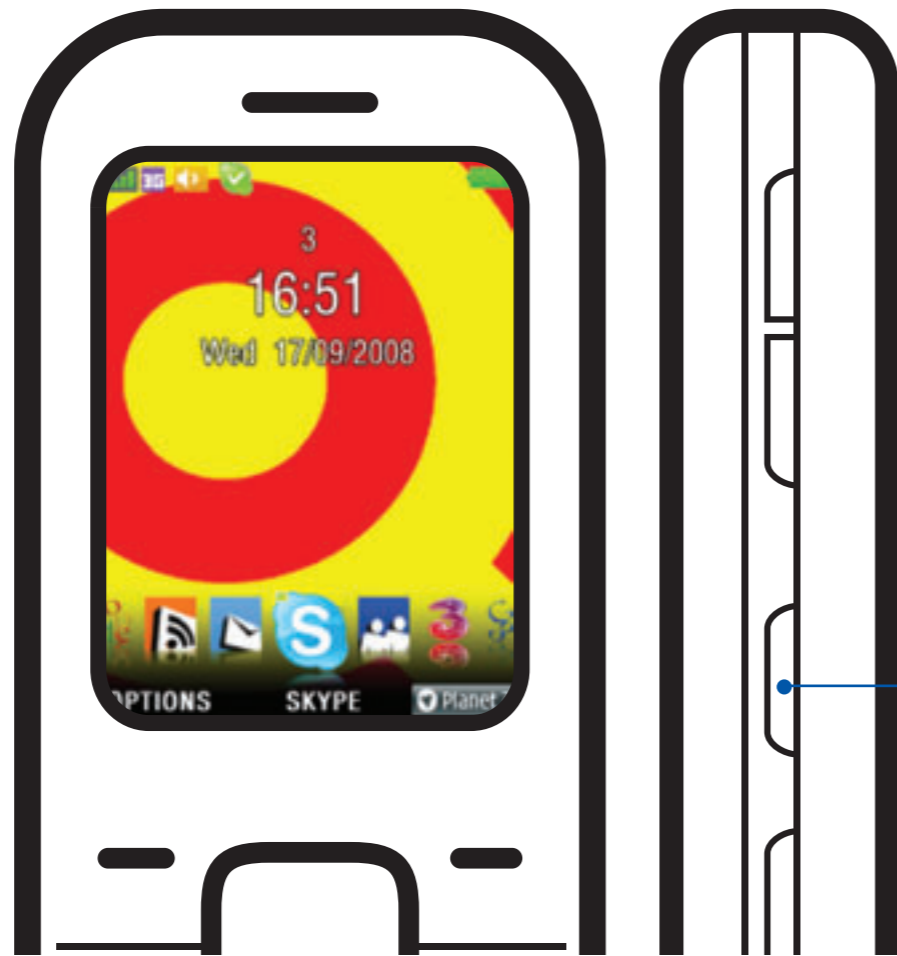

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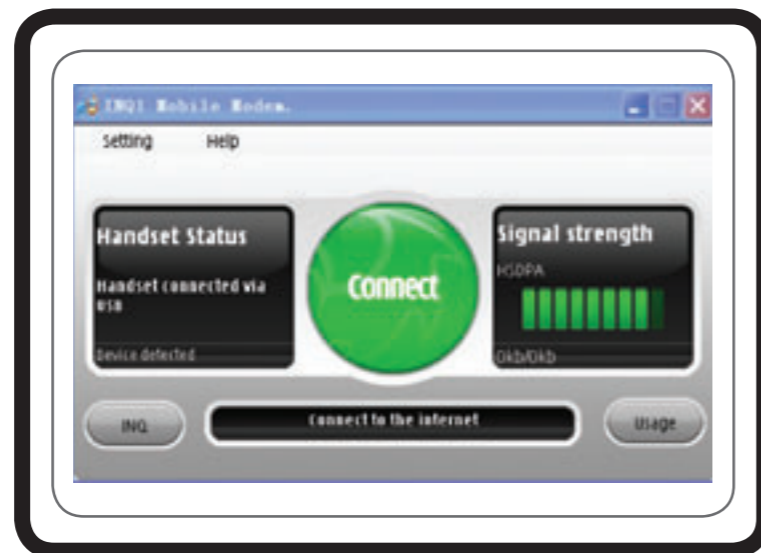
MOBILE MODEM - MAC

MOBILE MODEM – PC

Your mobile gives you an ultra high speed internet connection for your laptop when you're out and about.

It's simple to use as your mobile has in-built drivers that will automatically install when you first connect up to your PC.

Just plug your mobile into your laptop and installation will start automatically. The Mobile Modem software will start up on your laptop screen and you will see a button saying Connect. Click this and you'll get online.

The Mobile Modem software also shows you the strength of your mobile signal and how fast your internet connection is.

- Plug in your mobile to your Apple Mac and the INQ icon will show on your desktop. Double-click the INQ1 Driver Disc icon and select INQ1 USB Modem.pkg to install.
- On the Mobile Modem window select Connect to go online.
- Click Macintosh HD in desktop, select Applications > INQ1 Modem.

SIGN INTO SKYPE


With Skype on 3, you can make Skype-to-Skype calls and send instant messages from your mobile. Which means you can call and chat with people all over the world who use Skype, including other Skype on 3 users. You can also call phones abroad at Skype's great rates, using Skype credit.

IF YOU HAVE A SKYPE ACCOUNT

- Scroll to  from the Home screen and press OK.
- Select Sign in for existing users, then enter your username and password.
- Select Sign me in and set it as Automatically or Manually.
- If you select Automatically, you'll automatically sign into Skype each time you turn on your mobile.

IF YOU DON'T HAVE A SKYPE ACCOUNT

To create a new account:

- Scroll to  from the Home screen and press OK.
- Scroll to Create account for new users and press OK.

-  Invisible – others will see you as offline

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FACEBOOK FOR INQ

Facebook® is completely integrated into your mobile. So, for example, your Facebook friends are integrated with your contacts book and you can send photos direct from your camera to Facebook. You can update your status, send messages, etc. Facebook is always on so you'll be aware of any changes to your inbox, pokes or requests.

SIGN IN

- Scroll to  from the Home screen and press OK.
- Enter email address and password you use on Facebook or click on 'Need an account?'
- After you sign in for the first time, you will be asked if you want to add your Facebook friends to your Contacts, which we recommend you do. Then you will be able to see their status, their wall, send them messages and even give them a poke.
- To add friends to Contacts at a later date, select Friends and scroll  (left) to the Mobile Friends tab. Select Edit mobile friends.

Once you are signed in the application will continually run

in the background until you sign out.

- Within a few seconds your current Watches, buying and selling views will update.

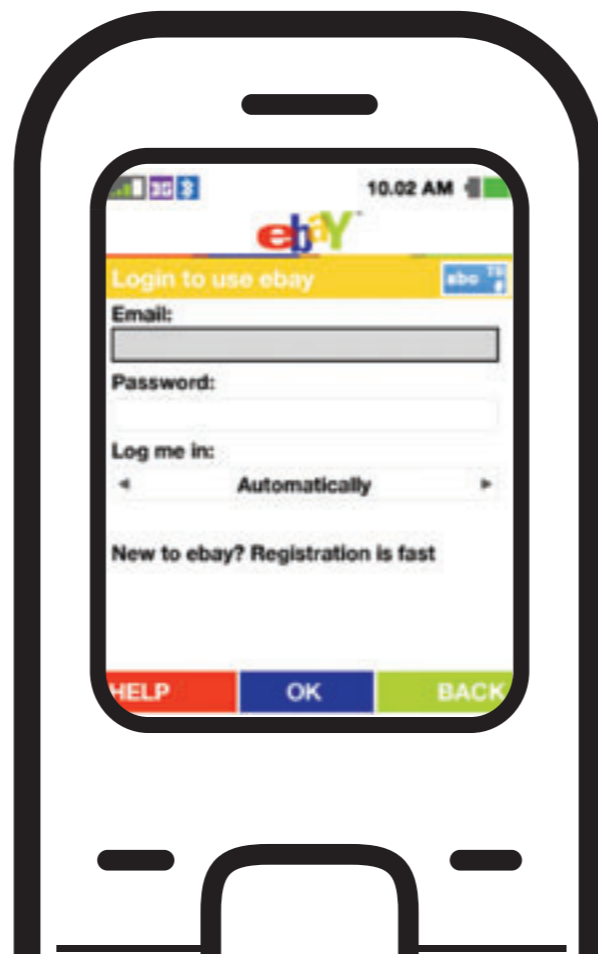

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LAST.FM

Last.fm is the world's leading free global music website, with a community of over 25 million passionate music fans. The 'scrobbling' function enables Last.fm to track what you listen to in real-time, and build you an online profile to store your music preferences. Last.fm can then recommend you new music based on your taste, as well as allowing your friends to see what you're into. And now you can scrobble from your mobile when you're listening to the music tracks you have stored on it.



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LAST.FM

SIGN IN

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen > MUSIC > OPTIONS > Last.fm > Log in.
- This will appear in the status bar when the Last.fm application is scrobbling.

SIGN OUT

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen > MUSIC. Select OPTIONS > Last.fm > Log out.

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INQMOBILE.COM

Feeds are basically a way of letting you know every time there's a change on a website you like, as long as it provides an RSS feed. That could mean updates on news, sports scores, entertainment gossip – whatever you're interested in. It's easy to choose a new feed and set it up. You can also set how often you want to be updated with any changes on the website.

ACCESS TO FEEDS

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen, and select FEEDS.

ADD A FEED

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select FEEDS.
- Select **OPTIONS > Add a feed > OK**.
- To add a web feed from your browser, look for the RSS icon . When you see it use the **OPTIONS** menu to add the feed.
- Alternatively, you can enter a feed URL manually and select **ADD**.

VIEW A FEED

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select **FEEDS > VIEW** or select **OPTIONS > View feed**.
- Select **GO TO** to go to the browser, where you'll see the full content of the website that sent the feed.

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UPDATE A FEED

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select FEEDS > OPTIONS > Update > Selected to update the single focus feed or select OPTIONS > Update > All to update the content of all feeds manually.
- While select OPTIONS > Set auto update to update the content of all feeds automatically. You can also set to auto update the feeds as Once an hour, Once a day, Once a week or Never.

MARK A FEED AS READ

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select FEEDS > OPTIONS > Mark as read to mark the selected feed as read.
- To mark all feeds as read, select OPTIONS > Mark all as read.

ASSIGN A FEED TO CONTACTS

- Press **MENU** from the Home screen and select FEEDS > MY FEEDS > OPTIONS > Assign feed to contact.
- Use **▲** (up) and **▼** (down) to select the desired contact and select MARK > DONE > YES to assign the feed to the contact.

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SET THE HOME SCREEN WIDGETS

With the widgets function, you can bring some of your most important internet services right to your desktop – things like the weather, RSS, Yahoo search, Clock, Google search.

- Press  (up) from the Home screen and select Click to add widgets > ADD to add a widget directly. The phone has five preset widgets for you to select: RSS Widget, Clock Widget, Yahoo Search Widget, Weather Widget, Google Search Widget.
- On the Manage Widgets screen, use  (up) or  (down) to scroll to the desired widget, then press OK to select it, or you can select OPTIONS > Select widget, then click DONE and the widget will appear on the Home screen.
- To search for the desired widget, you can enter the

widget name in the search bar until the widget is displayed. When you press a key, such as , you will find widget names that begin with 'A', 'B' or 'C'. The next key you press continues to narrow the search.

- Or you can select OPTIONS > View widget to view the details of the selected widget or select OPTIONS > Delete widget > YES to delete it.

NOTE:

If the widget is showing on the Home screen, please deselect it at first before deleting it.

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USING WEATHER WIDGETS

By supplying location information, you can view the weather forecast for 5 days or 2 days.

- After selecting Weather Widget on the Manage Widgets screen, the weather widget will appear on the Home screen. You can add a new weather location in the search bar, then click SEARCH, and the phone will display the related locations. Press OK, and the weather forecast of the selected location will shown on the screen.
- To add more locations, press OPTIONS > Add new location > OK, then add the additional location in the search bar and click SEARCH. The weather information of the additional location will also be shown on the screen. Press  (left) or  (right) to switch between the different locations.
- To remove the unwanted location, when the weather forecast of the selected location displays on the screen. Press OPTIONS > Remove this location > OK.

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USING CLOCK WIDGETS

With the clock widget, you can adjust the time and date, add or remove time zone, set the alarm and clock, etc.

- To set an alarm, after selecting Clock Widget on the Manage widget screen, the clock widget will appear on the Home screen. Select the clock widget and click OPTIONS > Alarm, scroll to Alarm1. Press OK to set your alarm. After setting, select SAVE. Click Cancel all to turn off the alarm function.
- To adjust the time and date, highlight the clock widget from the Home screen and click OPTIONS > Adjust time and date, then enter the date and time and select the desired time format and date format. After editing, select SAVE.
- To add a time zone, highlight the clock widget from the Home screen and select OPTIONS > Add time zone, then use  (up) or  (down) to select the desired location or you can enter the location name in the search bar until the location is displayed. Click ADD > OK, and the time of the selected location will display on the Home screen. To add more time zones, repeat this step and use  (left) or  (right) to switch between different time zones.

- To set a clock, highlight the clock widget from the Home screen and click **OPTIONS** > Analogue Clock/Digital Clock and press OK.

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EMAIL ON 3

Email on 3 pushes all your emails straight to your phone – personal and work. Compatible with almost any email service, including Microsoft Hotmail, Google Mail and Yahoo! Mail, as well as most corporate work email systems (Microsoft Exchange and Lotus Domino). Add up to 7 email accounts – never miss that important email again. Set up push schedules, so you're in control of your email, instead of it being in control of you.

To make a call from the Home screen:

- Enter the phone number.
- Press  to make a voice call.
- Select **OPTIONS > Video call > OK** for a video call.

- Scroll to your preferred contact and press  for voice call.
- Scroll to your preferred contact and select **OPTIONS > Call > Video call > OK** for a video call.

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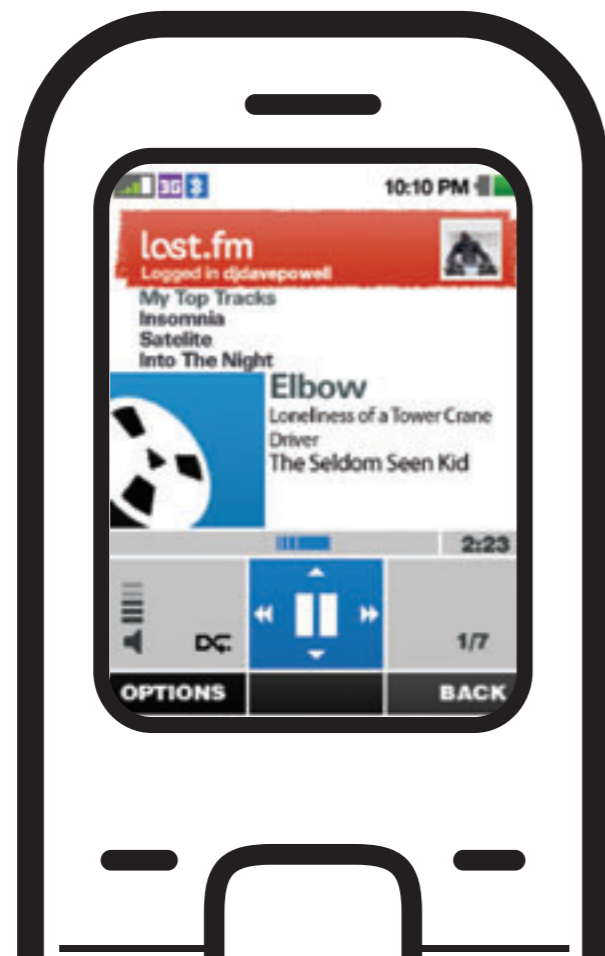

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
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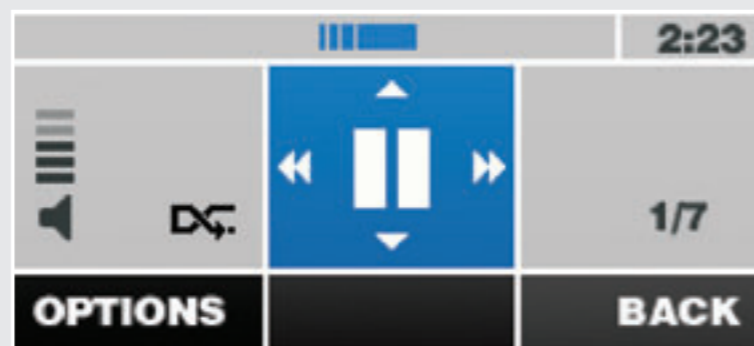

Once you have activated your PIN, each time you turn on your mobile, you'll need to enter your PIN.

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LANGUAGE

Keep track of your appointments and updates of your contacts by copying them to your PC and connect to your friends' mobiles with Bluetooth®.

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CONNECT WITH A BLUETOOTH® HEADSET

Before making calls with a Bluetooth® headset, you must first set up the headset to work with your mobile. Once you've done this, your mobile remembers the headset's ID. You can find more details in your Bluetooth® headset user guide.

To connect with a Bluetooth® headset:

- Press **MENU**.
- Scroll to select **SETTINGS** > Bluetooth > Switch on > **SELECT** to switch on the Bluetooth® function.
- Scroll to Search for new devices > **SELECT**.

Make sure that your headset's Bluetooth® is switched on. See your Bluetooth® headset user guide for how to connect your mobile and headset.

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TRANSFER FILES FROM YOUR MOBILE USING BLUETOOTH®

You can transfer files from your mobile to PC or to other mobiles via Bluetooth®.

- Press **MENU**.
- Scroll to select MY STUFF and select your preferred file.
- Select OPTIONS > Send as > Bluetooth > Select SEARCH and select the device you want to transfer to, then follow the instructions.

TRANSFER FILES BETWEEN YOUR MOBILE AND PC

Connect your mobile and PC using the USB cable. You don't need to install any drivers on your PC. You'll need to make sure that your mobile's memory card is inserted.

- First insert the USB cable into your handset and your PC.
- Select Memory card transfer.
- Open your media folder on your PC. Then drag and drop your preferred tracks between your PC and mobile.

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PC SYNCHRONISATION

THE MOBILE CAN'T BE SWITCHED ON

POSSIBLE REASON

SOLUTION

You are not holding  down for long enough.

Press and hold.

The battery power is used up.

Charge the battery.

Incorrect battery insertion.

Check and insert the battery correctly.

THE MOBILE IS SWITCHED OFF AUTOMATICALLY

POSSIBLE REASON

SOLUTION

Low battery power.

Charge the battery.

THE CALL VOLUME IS TOO LOW

POSSIBLE REASON

SOLUTION

The call volume has been set too low.

Increase the call volume.



TROUBLESHOOTING

THE PERSON YOU ARE CALLING CANNOT HEAR YOUR VOICE

POSSIBLE REASON

Call status has been set to mute.

The microphone is too far from the sound source.

SOLUTION

Turn off the mute function on the call menu.

Put the mobile's microphone closer to your mouth.

THE INCOMING CALL DOESN'T RING

POSSIBLE REASON

The mobile has been set to silent mode.

The ring volume has been set too low.

The call diverting option has been set.

SOLUTION

Reset the ring type in Profiles to Normal or Loud.

Increase the volume in Profiles.

Cancel call diverting in Settings.

THE BATTERY CAN'T BE CHARGED

POSSIBLE REASON

The battery is worn out and the charging time takes too long.

The battery doesn't connect well to the mobile.

SOLUTION

Charge when the mobile prompts low battery.

Ensure the battery has been inserted correctly.

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CAN'T DISPLAY NETWORK

POSSIBLE REASON

The USIM card has been incorrectly inserted.

The phone has been set to Airplane Mode.

SOLUTION

Refer to the USIM card insertion method.

Change the setting when it is safe to do so.

THE MOBILE DOES NOT RECOGNISE THE MEMORY CARD

POSSIBLE REASON

The memory card has been incorrectly inserted.

The memory card has been damaged.

SOLUTION

Insert the memory card correctly according to instructions in the user manual.

Replace the memory card.

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SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

USAGE ENVIRONMENT

Please remember to obey the relevant rules and regulations whenever you use your handset. This will help keep you and others around you safe.

Here are some general rules related to use of your handset in certain places:

- Using your handset in a plane can cause interference to the aircraft navigation system and communications. Switch off your handset before boarding and, unless use is permitted by the airline, switch off your handset during the flight.
- To keep safe on the road, do not use the handset when driving. If you must use it, and it is permitted in your country, use a hands-free kit with a fixed cradle (and make sure you still exercise proper control of the vehicle) or stop at a safe location by the roadside before making or answering a call.
- Switch off your handset when in petrol stations or any area with flammables, explosives or chemicals and follow any safety signs and instructions.

GENERAL SAFETY AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Your handset is a sensitive piece of equipment, always place it somewhere safe and not where it could fall and break.
- Do not expose the handset or battery to extreme heat or sun (such as on a car dashboard or window sill) as this may cause the handset or battery to overheat and cause physical injury.

MEDICAL DEVICES

- Please switch off your handset when in a hospital or near any electronic medical equipment. Some personal medical devices can shield the handset's RF signal, but some can't. If you have any questions or need to find out more, please consult your doctor or the medical device manufacturer.

PACEMAKERS

- To avoid interference with a pacemaker, pacemaker manufacturers advise keeping a distance between your handset and heart pacemaker of at least 6 inches (15cm).

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SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

- Anyone wearing a pacemaker should keep a distance between the handset and pacemaker of more than 6 inches (15cm) when the handset is switched on and avoid carrying the handset in a breast pocket. When talking listen with the handset ear on the opposite side of the body to the pacemaker.

HEARING AIDS

- Phones may cause interference to some hearing aids. If there is any interference, please contact the manufacturer of your hearing aid for advice.

EMERGENCY CALLS

- Your handset may not always be in range of a mobile network and networks are sometimes unavailable, so you should not rely on your mobile phone as the only means of communication in an emergency.

TO MAKE AN EMERGENCY CALL

- Ensure your handset is switched on.
- Input the local emergency number correctly (such as 999). Different countries have different emergency numbers. Dial 112 if you do not know the local emergency services number.

- Press the call button.
- Provide all important information to emergency services as accurately as possible.

BATTERY INFORMATION AND CARE

- Always use the battery and charger provided with the handset or which is approved for use with the handset.
- Do not touch the handset, battery or charger with wet hands while it is charging.
- Switch off the handset and disconnect the charger before removing the battery from the handset.
- Do not leave the handset or battery in places with extreme heat or cold (such as in a car during summer or winter), or the battery life will be shortened.
- Do not short-circuit the battery. Accidental short-circuiting can occur when a metal object (coin, clip or pen) causes a direct connection between the contacts of the battery, for example when you carry a spare battery in a pocket or bag.
- Do not burn your handset battery or treat it as ordinary rubbish. Please follow the local environmental policy in

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order to avoid endangering life and causing environmental damage. Please use any battery recycling service.

- If your battery leaks, dispose of it immediately and do not attempt to save it.
- The handset uses a lithium battery. How long a charged battery lasts will be influenced by your use of the handset features, the strength of the network signal and the handset settings.
- Generally, the charging time is 3-5 hours according to the current status of the handset (whether switched on, making a call, etc).
- To extend the battery to life when the battery is new fully charge and discharge the battery (in the handset) two or three times.
- Never use a battery that has been damaged.
- Make sure the battery is properly installed in the handset.
- If the battery life becomes noticeably shorter than normal, it is time to buy a new battery.
- Only use batteries that are approved by INQ for use with your handset and only

recharge your battery with a compatible charger.

- If a charger is not in use, disconnect it from the power source. Do not leave the battery connected to a charger for more than a week, as overcharging may shorten its life.
- When you are not using your handset, it is a good idea to switch it off to save energy.

NOTE ABOUT ACCESSORIES

- You should pull out the plug of any charger or handset or other cable safely and slowly.
- If your handset, battery, or charger is not operating normally, please contact your network operator or an approved service centre as soon as possible.

OTHER SAFETY INFORMATION

- If you use earphones to listen to music or watch video, please do not turn up the volume too high as this could damage your hearing.
- Do not attempt to repair or dismantle the handset. This should be left to qualified staff and will void any warranty.

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PHONE PASSWORD

- This protects your handset from unauthorised use by other people. The preset password is 0000. Please modify your handset password as soon as possible and keep it secret.

PIN CODE

- This is a personal identification code which is used to protect the USIM card from unauthorised use by other people. Generally, the PIN code is supplied with your USIM card. After activating the PIN code, you must correctly input your password each time to activate the handset.
- If you input your PIN code incorrectly three times in succession, the USIM card will be locked. You will need to input the PUK code to unlock it. (If you do not have a PUK code, please contact the network operator for this information. Make sure to input all characters.)

PUK CODE

- This is used to unlock the PIN code. If you incorrectly input the PUK code ten times in a row, then the USIM card cannot be used again. Usually the PUK

code and USIM card are provided together. If you lose PUK code or it isn't supplied with USIM card, please contact your network operator or USIM card provider.

PIN2 CODE

- This is the password which activates the special USIM card functions. Usually, the PIN2 code and the USIM card will be provided together. If you incorrectly input the PIN2 code three times in succession, it will be locked and you will need to input PUK2 to unlock it again.

PUK2 CODE

- This is used to unlock the PIN2 code.
- Usually the PUK2 code and the USIM card are provided together. PUK2 can modify the locked PIN2 code. If you incorrectly input the PUK2 code ten times in a row, you will not be able to access some of the functions. Please apply to your operator for a new USIM card. The PUK2 code cannot be changed. If you lose it, please contact your service provider.

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
